Stephen Flint is retired Clinical Professor and Consultant in Oral Medicine and former Head of the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Medicine, Pathology and Radiology at the Dublin Dental University Hospital, where he was also Pro-Dean. His research interests include oral manifestations of systemic diseases and infections with HIV, *Candida*, herpesvirus and papillomavirus group viruses and oral cancer. He is both medically and dentally qualified, holds a PhD in molecular biology and has Fellowships from the Royal College of Surgeons of both England and Ireland, the International College of Dentists and Trinity College, Dublin. He has sat on a number of European and Irish national committees, including Europe against Cancer and the European HIV advisory committees and the Scientific Advisory Committee of the Irish Health Protection Surveillance Centre, of which he is a former chairman, and the Irish Medicines Board. He has numerous publications in international journals and is co-author of Oral and Maxillofacial Diseases, a textbook atlas, now in its 4th edition and published in five languages.
